FIM SuperEnduro World Championship

2020 Calendar update 10 March - Final in Lodz, Poland POSTPONED

Due to the ongoing coronavirus outbreak, a decision has been taken to postpone the final round of the FIM SuperEnduro World Championship that was scheduled to take place on 14 March at the Atlas Arena in Lodz, Poland.

As the global outbreak of coronavirus continues to develop, the Regional authorities of Lodz has decided to cancel all the mass events scheduled in the region until further notice.

The Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM), the Polish Federation (PZM) and the promoter ABC Communications therefore regret to announce that the event has been postponed.

All parties are currently evaluating if it will be possible to re-schedule the event later this season.

Further updates will be issued in due course.
