FIM Speedway Grand Prix of Poland Re-Scheduled

Due to a ban imposed by the Polish government on all outdoor events until further notice amid global health concerns over COVID-19 (coronavirus), the 2020 PZM Warsaw FIM Speedway Grand Prix of Poland on May 16 has been postponed.

This decision was made after careful consideration and consultation with the Polish Automobile and Motorcycle Federation, the FIM, BSI Speedway and PL.2012+ (PGE Narodowy Stadium operator), out of concern for the safety of riders and supporters.

The event has been provisionally re-scheduled for August 8. Further event details will be made available as soon as they have been finalised.
