FIM Flat Track World Championship

2020 Calendar UPDATE 12 August

In view with the ongoing restrictions in place in Italy due to the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, the FIM, the Italian Motorcycling Federation and the local organiser would like to confirm that the event that was set to take place in Boves-Cuneo in Italy and that was already postponed until 26 September has now been rescheduled to 24 October as the final of the 2020 FIM Flat Track World Championship.

All parties will continue to monitor the situation and will communicate in a timely manner if further schedule changes are required.
