MXGP of Patagonia-Argentina postponed to 2021

The FIM and Infront Moto Racing regret to confirm that the MXGP of Patagonia-Argentina, originally due to take place on 21/22 November has now been postponed to 2021.

Despite the hard work and best efforts of Infront Moto Racing, the FIM and the local organiser, Más Eventos to put on another fantastic event in Argentina, unfortunately due to the difficult health conditions as a result of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19), as well as the current travel restrictions, this year's event is unable to take place.

As a result, the sixth edition of the MXGP of Patagonia-Argentina will instead be celebrated in 2021, with Infront Moto Racing and Más Eventos continuing to work closely together to put on an even better event next season. Additionally, Más Eventos have agreed to extend the duration of their contract to 2022, which means Villa la Angostura, Neuquen is guaranteed to be on the FIM Motocross World Championship racing calendar for the next two seasons!

Those who have purchased their tickets for this season's event will be able to either use the existing ticket as part of the payment for the 2021 event, obtaining a 30% discount or ask for reimbursement through Ticketek: <http://www.ticketek.com.ar/customerservice/>.
