BP Ultimate Portugal Rally and Baja do Pinhal postponed

In light with the ongoing impact of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and current travel restrictions in Portugal, the Fédération Internationale de Motocyclisme (FIM), the Federação de Motociclismo de Portugal (FMP) and the organizers, Automóvel Club de Portugal and Escuderia Castelo Branco have taken the decision to postpone the BP Ultimate Portugal Rally originally scheduled to take place on 09-13 April and the Baja do Pinhal on 28-30 May.

All parties are currently working with the stake holders involved to re-schedule both events later this season.

Further updates will be issued in due course.

The FIM was the first international sports federation to impose an Environmental Code in 1994.
