Tyres: Riders may use 'Mitas' tyres which will be provided by the organiser. 5 tyres will be supplied free of charge and additional 'Mitas' tyres will be available at a cost of \$65 approx per tyre.

Additionally, riders are free to use any current FIM homologated tyre. In this case the tyres intended for use during the meeting must be presented unfitted to the technical team for checking and marking at the time specified in the published tyre fitting schedule. These tyres will be at rider's own cost and must be purchased in advance as they will not be available at the track.

Riders may use their own homologated tyres during practice.

Protests and Appeals:

Any person or group of persons - rider, passenger, sponsor, manufacturer, official, etc., recognised by the FIM and concerned by a decision taken under the authority of the FIM, has the right to protest against that decision before the International Jury, except in the case of statement of fact.

Generally, protests against the eligibility of a rider, passenger, entrant or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the official practice.

Protests against results must be presented to the International Jury within 30 minutes following the publication of the results.

An appeal may be made against a decision of the International Jury to the International Disciplinary Court (CDI), according to Art. 4.5 and 4.6 of the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code.

All protests to the International Jury must be made in accordance with the requirement of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code of the FIM and be accompanied by a security deposit of 660 Euros - or \$985.00 (equivalent amount in local currency) returnable if the protest is justified or forfeited if the Disciplinary body considers the protest to be groundless, or if it is withdrawn without a hearing.
