Grid in the pit lane (riders starting the race from there)

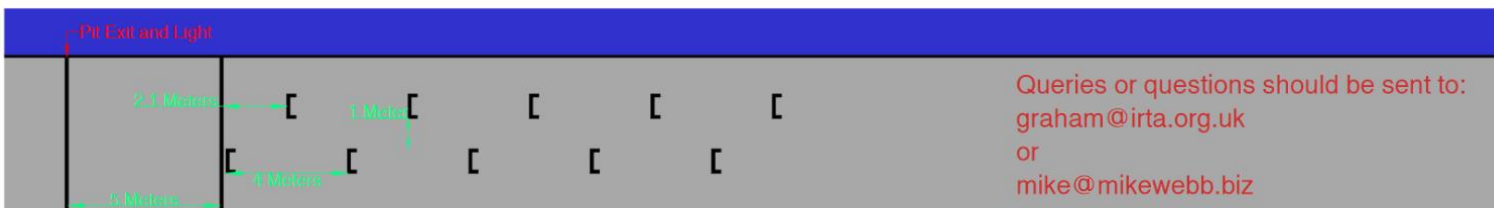
Dear Sir or Madam,

In application of Art.1.18.16 of the 2019 FIM World Championship Grand Prix Regulations, when (less than 11) riders start the race from the pit lane, they will line up in painted grid positions in the order that they arrive.

Depending on the specificities and facilities of the circuit, the location of this grid in the pit lane may be adapted. However, this grid could be configured (with approved paint) as follows.

The GP Race Direction will give at each circuit their instructions for the location.

For information, this type of grid will also be used for Moto3 Junior World Championship races.



- Pit Exit Grid should replicate the official grid on track.
ie. 1st position on the left or the right, following the layout of the official Grid
- 1st Grid position should be painted 100mm back from the white line.
- 5 Grid positions each side, total of 10 grids.
- There should be 1 meter lateral gap between the Grid positions.
- Total distance will be 18 meters from the 1st Grid position to 10th Grid position
