1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The BATC e.V. on behalf of the DMSB will organise the FIM Sidecar World Championship **third round** at Motorsport Arena Oschersleben. This meeting will be held on **19-21 July 2019** and will count towards the **2019** FIM Sidecar World Championship.

The Permanent teams will use their seasonal accreditation.

Other teams (“one event”) will get 8 pit lane accreditations per team:

- 5 for the mechanics/team’s members

The “one event” teams (only the rider or passenger) must personally collect their accreditation at the Accreditations Center upon presentation of an ID or passport

The Teams will be allowed to enter in the paddock from **Thursday 18 July from 18.00 o'clock**

4. CIRCUIT

The length of the circuit is 3,667 km.
The race will be run clockwise.

The organiser will select the applications and advise teams within 72 hours after the closing date of entries whether their applications have been accepted or rejected.

9. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

No rider or Sidecar is permitted onto the track unless he/it has passed the technical inspections. The technical checks will be done in the Techno Centre, next to the Control Tower:

Friday 19th July from 08.00 hrs to 11.30hrs

10. RIDERS BRIEFING

As per the Art. 1.8.2 of FIM Sidecar World Championship Regulations, all the riders and passengers must attend the compulsory briefing to be held on **Friday 19th July, in the VIP Lounge 14, at 10.00 hrs.**



11. PRACTISING

It is strictly forbidden to ride racing Sidecars on the course outside the official practice periods.

13. PRIZE-GIVING

Trophies will be provided by the organiser; one trophy for each rider and one for each passenger of the first three classified teams of each races.

The podium ceremony will take place on the official winner's rostrum above pit boxes, immediately after the finish of the race.

14. PROTESTS

All protests shall be made in accordance with the requirements of the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by a fee of 660 Euros.

15. FUEL

If fuel is supplied by the Organisers at the fuel-station, it will be in conformity with Article 2.10 of the FIM Sidecar World Championship Regulations.

16. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form the entry for the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider/passenger is insured in accordance with the FIM requirements.

In conformity with Art. 110.1 of the Sporting Code, third party insurance in respect of riders covering accidents occurring during the meeting including practices will be the responsibility of the organiser.

This insurance includes a minimum guarantee of 120 000 euros.

The organiser and/or promotor disclaims all responsibility for damage to a Sidecar, its accessories and all components arising out of an accident, fire or other cases.

17. CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT

Should circumstances of safety reasons demand it, the meeting of the FIM Sidecar World Championship could be postponed or cancelled. For this, the BATC e.V, nor the DMSB and nor the FIM can be held responsible.



18. RENUNCIATION OF ANY RECOURSE AGAINST SPORTING AUTHORITIES

Apart from the requirements of the FIM Sporting Code, riders and teams by participation renounce all rights of appeal against the organiser, his representatives or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM Sporting Code for any damages for which they could not be liable in consequence of all acts or omissions of the part of the organiser, his officials, representatives or agents in the application of these regulations or contributed to or arising out of their actions.

19. RIDERS EQUIPMENT

An on-board (other than the one from the FIM TV Crews or permitted by the FIM Administration) is not allowed during the entire event, from the practice sessions until the end of the event.

If riders wish to place their own on-board camera, they must contact the TV Department of the FIM Administration for approval at aurélie.grob@fim.ch

20. ENVIRONMENTAL MAT

As per Art. 4.1 of the FIM Environmental Code regarding the protection of the floor, Superside teams must accomplish the usage of a standardized environmental mat. This mat must be composed of an absorbent upper part and an impermeable lower part. The use of an environmental mat protecting the ground (or other effective system for events taking place at circuits with permanent facilities) to prevent soil and water contamination is compulsory:

- a) wherever work on motorcycles is allowed by the organisers;
- b) under all waste oil and fuel containers provided by the organisers;
- c) at all official refuelling points;
- d) under all thermic powered generators and power washers.

The minimum technical data for the mat are:

- Dimensions: Minimum 160 cm x 100 cm.

Any infraction of this rule will be reported to the International Jury who will fine the rider responsible a maximum of EUR 370,- or any other amount mentioned in the regulation or appendix of the discipline.

Other sanctions can be pronounced by the International Jury in accordance with the competences mentioned in Art. 3.1.3 of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code (DAC) and Ar. 50.1.3 of the Sporting Code.

He confirms that he is cognisant with and accepts the relevant FIM documents currently in force, including but not limited to the FIM Sporting Code, the FIM Statutes, the FIM Code of Ethics, the FIM Anti-Doping Code, the FIM Environmental Code, the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and the FIM Sidecar World Championship regulations currently in force as well as the Supplementary Regulations of each FIM Sidecar World Championship round.

PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

CEREMONIE DE REMISE DES PRIX

The rider having won a FIM World Championship title, in any class or discipline, must be present at the FIM Prize-giving Ceremony organised each year. A rider who does not attend the Ceremony will be subject to a minimum fine of CHF 10'000.- and of CHF 100'000.- maximum (FIM Sporting Code Art. 60.7).

Un coureur ayant remporté un titre de Champion du Monde FIM, dans n'importe quelle classe ou discipline, doit être présent à la Cérémonie de Remise des Prix FIM. Un coureur qui n'assiste pas à la Cérémonie est passible d'une amende d'un montant minimum de CHF 10'000.- et de CHF 100'000.- maximum (Code Sportif FIM Art. 60.7).

Non-participation in an event

Any rider who enters an event shall inform the organiser if, subsequently, he decides not to participate in the event. A rider who has submitted an entry form and fails to participate will be reported by the International Jury to the FIM, who will impose the following penalties:

- First offence: fine of 150 €
- Subsequent offences in the same season: Suspension from the next event counting towards the Championship

Upon receipt of the International Jury's report, the FIM Administration will send a letter to the rider's FMN asking the reasons for the non-participation; a reply should be sent within 15 days at the latest and a decision will be taken regarding the penalty.

An exclusion could also be pronounced against a rider who takes part in another event on the same day.

Le coureur ayant envoyé un bulletin d'engagement et qui ne participe pas à la manifestation fera l'objet d'un rapport du Jury International auprès de la FIM qui infligera les sanctions suivantes :

- Première infraction : amende de 150 €.
- Récidives au cours de la même saison : suspension de la prochaine manifestation comptant pour le Championnat.

Dès réception du rapport du Jury International, l'Administration de la FIM enverra une lettre à la FMN du coureur en demandant les raisons de la non-participation; la réponse devra parvenir dans un délai maximum de 15 jours et une décision sera prise quant à l'application de la sanction.

Une exclusion sera également prononcée à l'encontre d'un coureur qui, le même jour, participe à une autre manifestation.
