

**SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS
FOR THE FIM X-TRIAL WORLD
CHAMPIONSHIP**

ARTICLE 1 : ANNOUNCEMENT

The Club AMCF and the promotion company AMCF SPORT are organising the final round of the FIM X-Trial World Championship on behalf of the French Motorcycling Federation (FFM). The event will be held in accordance with the Sporting Code of the FIM together with relevant Appendices, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions, approved by the Referee. The event must respect the FIM Environmental Code.

The event will be held on 31st March 2012 at the Palais Omnisports de Paris Bercy in Paris, France.

ARTICLE 2. ENTRIES

Entries for the whole Championship or for one event must be made on the official entry form and sent to the CTR Administration at the FIM headquarters. All entries must be received by 16th March 2012.

All riders must have their entry endorsed by their federation.

The number of admitted riders for the qualification is 10 including the 8 fixed riders of the championship.

Name of the wild card riders invited by the organiser: 1) Benoît Dagnicourt, 2) Alexandre Ferrer.

ARTICLE 3. TECHNICAL CONTROL AND REGISTRATION

The administrative and technical control will take place on 31st March 2012 after the information meeting.

Each machine must comply with all the requirements of Art. 057.9.1 of the FIM Trial rules. At the technical control, the rider must submit his valid FIM World Championship rider's licence, together with his helmet.

ARTICLE 4. SPONSORS

ARTICLE 5. STARTING ORDER

The starting time and starting order will be established according to Art. 057.8.3. and to the arrangements below:

The first rider for the qualification will start at: 19:00

The first rider for the Trial will start at: 21:00

Starting order for the qualification in accordance with Art. 057.8.3.1.

Starting order for the Trial in accordance with Art. 057.8.3.2.

ARTICLE 6. COURSE

At the **qualification**, there will be 5 normal sections.

At the **Trial**, there will be at least 7 normal sections and 1 double lane section.

ARTICLE 7. TIME ALLOWANCE

Qualification: the time allowance for each rider will be 7 minutes.

The time penalty will be 1 point for each 30 seconds, or part thereof, in excess of the allowed time.

Trial: the time allowance for each rider will be decided by the Referee.

The time penalty will be 1 point for each 30 seconds, or part thereof, in excess of the allowed time.

ARTICLE 8. QUALIFICATION FOR THE TRIAL

The format of the qualification will be one rider passing all sections in a row.

The 6 best riders of the qualification will participate in the Trial.

ARTICLE 9. TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

In case of technical incidents, riders must immediately use their second motorcycle. No extra time shall be granted for changing motorcycle (Art. 057.9.4).

ARTICLE 10. DECISION BETWEEN THE TIES

Qualification: the decision between the ties will be made according to Art. 057.14.1.

Trial: the decision between the ties will be made according to Art. 057.14.2.

ARTICLE 11. RESULTS

The classification will be established according to Art. 057.12.

ARTICLE 12. PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded, on the podium, to the first 3 riders. The payment of financial awards will be made according to Art. 057.15.2.

ARTICLE 13. VISIT OF THE SECTIONS AND INFORMATION MEETING

The visit of the sections will take place 4 hours before the beginning of the event and will be followed by the information meeting.
