## FIM Anti-doping controls FIM Motocross World Championships

Anti-doping controls were carried out at FIM Motocross MX1&MX2 World Championships and FIM Women's World Championship meeting, held in Locket (CZE) on 8 August.

No prohibited substances or their metabolites, or markers, or the use of prohibited methods were found in the tested samples.
