ANNOUNCEMENT

The MOBILITYLAND CORP and MOTORCYCLE FEDERATION OF JAPAN (MFJ) will promote the 3rd round of the FIM Trial World Championship, FIM Junior Trial World Cup and FIM Youth Trial Cup 125cc. The event will be held in accordance with the Sporting Code of the FIM together with relevant Appendices, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Final Instructions, approved by the Jury. The event has to respect the FIM Environmental Code.

The event will be held on 05-06 June 2010 at Twinring Motegi, Japan.

1. ENTRIES

Entries must be made on the official entry form and sent to the FIM Secretariat. All entries must be received by 21 May 2010.

All riders must have their entry endorsed by their own FMN.

2. TECHNICAL CONTROL AND REGISTRATION

The administrative and technical controls will take place on Friday 04 June 2010 between 09:30 and 11:30.

A second technical control shall take place on Saturday 05 June 2010 and Sunday 06 June 2010, 10 min. before the start of each rider.

Each machine must be road legal for the Country in which it is registered, and comply with all requirements of the FIM Technical regulations including those under Art. 052.8.1. Parts will be marked in accordance with Art. 052.8.4. Sound level control will be carried out in accordance with Art. 052.8.3.

At administration control, all riders in the World Championship must submit their FIM World Championship licence and all riders in the FIM Junior Trial World Cup and the FIM Youth Trial Cup 125cc must submit their FIM World Championship licence or Continental Championship or International licence, valid for the event.

At the technical control, all riders must submit the administrative documents of their motorcycles and a helmet, according to the FIM standards.

3. BIBS

The riders must wear the bib given by the CTR.

4. STARTING ORDER

1st DAY

The starting order will be decided according to Art. 052.7.7.

Last starter will depart at 11:00 on 05 June 2010.

2nd DAY

The starting order will be decided by the riders' performance in the 1st day, see Art. 052.7.8.

Last starter will depart at 11:00 on 06 June 2010.

5. COURSE AND TIME

The length of the course is of 7 km for all FIM Trial World Championship participants.

The course will consist of TWO laps of 15 sections each day for FIM Trial World Championship participants.

The course will consist of TWO laps of 13 sections, each day, for the FIM Junior Trial World Cup and FIM Youth Trial Cup 125cc participants.

The Individual limit for riders will be of 5h00 each day (3h00 for the first lap).

6. PADDOCK/PRACTICE

The Paddock will be opened to all riders from the Thursday before the event at 13:00.

Any rider found practising outside the areas set aside by the organisers may not be allowed to start.

The practice area must be open to all riders one day before the event.

7. HEADQUARTERS AND JURY MEETINGS

The Headquarters for the event will be at Grandstand, Jury meeting will be held at Grandstand.

The meeting with the organisers and the Jury President and/or the CTR Representative will be held the Thursday before the event at 18:00.

The first Jury meeting will be held on the Friday before the event at 18:00.

8. AWARDS

For the FIM Trial World Championship, FIM Junior Trial World Cup and FIM Youth Trial Cup 125cc, awards shall be given to at least the first 3 placed riders of each Championship for each day.

9. PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The Prize-Giving Ceremony will take place each day in the start area within 15 minutes of the final classified rider arriving at the finish.
